Terms and Conditions

The RJ4All Restorative Justice E-library is a free resource accessible by everyone independently of location. By using this resource you agree to the following Terms and Conditions (T&Cs)

The E-library is owned and operated by the Restorative Justice for All International Institute (which will be referred to as "RJ4All", "us", or "our")

In entering our site, you the user ("You") are accepting our Terms and Conditions. If you do not agree with any part of these terms, you must not use the e-library.

1. Access and Use:

The RJ4All E-Library caters for informational and educational purposes. Access to the e-library is granted to individuals and organisations interested in the field of restorative justice and social justice, subject to compliance with these terms and conditions.

The access to the E-Library is free and open to everyone without the need to register membership.

The usage of the library for commercial purposes is **not allowed**.
